

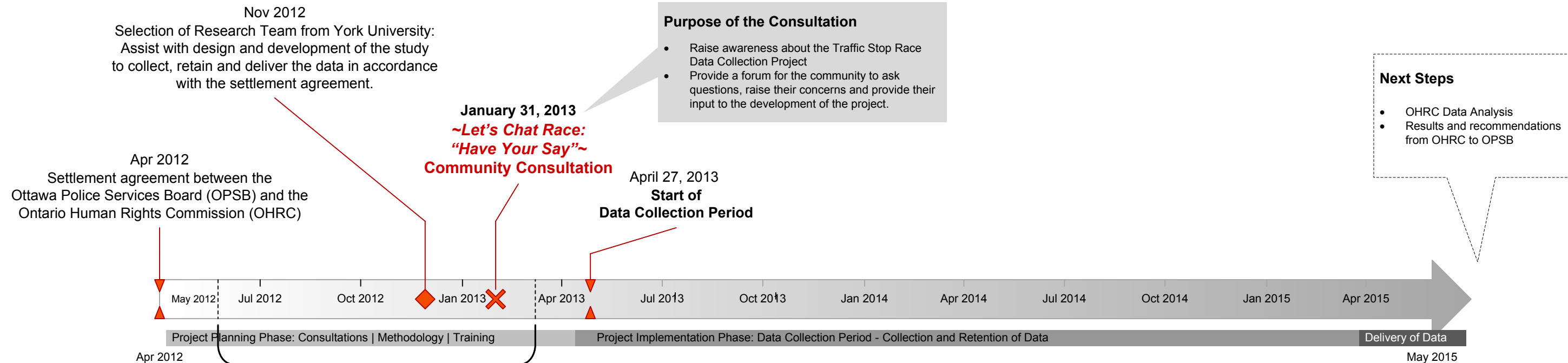

Settlement Highlights

- The settlement provides for race-based data collection on traffic stops by Ottawa Police Service (OPS) for a period of two years.
- The Project will record the observational assessments of driver race by OPS officers.
- The data will not be used in discipline or performance appraisals.
- The data collection will commence within 12 months of the signature date of the agreement (April 27, 2012).
- The settlement provides for a consultation process with the community.
- A mutually agreed upon expert in relation to race-based data collection will be engaged to work on this project.
- At the end of the project, the data will be made available to OHRC.
- The OPSB will give good faith considerations of study recommendations by the OHRC.

Goals of the Project

- To continue the ongoing work related to ensuring bias-free policing.
- To continue to promote trust and confidence in the police by addressing and discussing community concerns.
- To continue a commitment to openness and accountability.
- To advance the study of the collection of race-based data.
- The data collected will be used in a manner that is consistent with the *Ontario Human Rights Code*.
